## **FUNDRAISING AND DEVELOPMENT**

As you may already know we received a capital grant of €95,000 in the funding round in the Autumn. Thanks to everyone involved from inside and outside the club in securing this much needed funding. As with a lot of things in life there are some terms and conditions attached to these funds. The primary one is that **this money must be used to develop the proposed astroturf facility** which is to be sited at the bottom of the Kilcornan grounds on the area currently covered in gravel. If we do not use this money for that purpose then it cannot be used for anything else. This has obvious implications for the club in terms of fundraising over the coming years and there has been serious discussion on this matter at committee level over the past months.

Ultimately we believe that the development of the astroturf facility is something that will help create a legacy for the club and provide a facility that will serve players for many years to come and we need to take this opportunity to deliver that facility, and it's a fitting way to crown the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the club.

We will communicate the plans for the grounds and the necessary fundraising over the coming year. One event that has already been planned is a Golf Outing on the 13<sup>th</sup> of May 2016 at the Galway Bay Golf Club. Colga FC entered a team into the GFA U15 league for the 2015-2016 season. 11 players and 3 coaches attended the 1<sup>st</sup> session in mid August and the current squad (managed by Brian O'Neill, assisted by Declan murray and Eoin Greaney ) consists of 16 players born in 2001 and 3 players born in 2002 and have had 28 training sessions on grass and astroturf to date with the squad also gratefully accepting Olly Mullins expertise for additional coaching. The team plays an attack oriented 4-3-3 formation which has lead to consistent creation of chances and scoring in every game but has also put huge demands on midfield to b create and defend against 4 opposition midfielders for 70 minutes.

It has been a roller coaster first half of the 10 round league so far with 7 points total (2 wins, 2 losses and 1 draw) is not a fair reflection of our play and dominance of some matches.


